Reading

Key text: Girl who stole an Elephant

In reading we will develop our fluency, vocabulary, comprehension and summarising skills using our key text.

<u>Geography</u>

How do rainforests and their rivers impact the environment and human life; what are the consequences of changes to them?

We will explore the rainforest biome, looking at the importance of rivers like the Amazon. We will explore how deforestation impacts on rainforests as well as its wider global effect.

Science: Living things and their habitats.

What does life look like in the rainforest?

Linking with our work in Geography, we will be exploring the life cycles of rainforest animals: amphibians, mammals, insects and birds

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Art

How do different artists create their art?

We will be looking at the work of the Brazilian artist, Beatriz Milhazes, and learning about where she gets her inspiration while using her art as a model to create our own.

Computing: We are architects

We will become architects and design and create an virtual art gallery to showcase our artwork from this term.

Writing

What makes a good adventure story?

We will be using the key text to help us write our own adventure story, learning important grammatical skills and devices to help us build tension, describe exotic locations, narrate chase scenes and create exciting cliffhangers. We will also create descriptive flashback scences to enhance our stories, using emotive devices.

GEOGRAPHY

French

How do we describe out families in French?

We will learn how to talk about ourselves in French, describing ourselves and our families.
