Stonehouse Park Federation Breakfast and After School Club Behaviour Agreement

We believe that breakfast and after school child care should provide a relaxed, comfortable environment where children are encouraged to play, socialise, and create. In order to provide this type of environment, we have a flexible structure enabling the children to choose from many different activities. This is only possible if children accept the responsibility to follow these expectations, and we have your cooperation in impressing the importance of these guidelines.

Our code of conduct is primarily the same as at our schools:

Be kind

Follow directions from trusted adults leading club

Show respect for other children and for adults in language and actions

Respect the property of the school and other children

Use good table manners, talk quietly and stay seated while eating

Share all play and craft equipment

Use all play and craft equipment safely and properly

Stay in the approved supervised areas

Appropriate behaviour will be praised and rewarded with extra time on chosen activities. Inappropriate behaviour will result in the following consequences:

- 1) the child will be reminded of expected behaviour
- 2) the child will receive an opportunity to make another choice
- 3) the child will miss opportunity to participate in a craft or game
- 4) the child and his/her parent will have a discussion or meeting with staff

Please note that children must not bring their own food to breakfast club and cannot bring toys, games or electronic equipment to either breakfast or after school club.

<u>Serious misconduct</u>: Stealing, intentional damages of property, physical assault on another person, profane or obscene language or open defiance of a member of staff may result in an having to leave the after school and/or breakfast provision with immediate effect. The parent will be responsible for reimbursing the program for the cost of damaged items. The After School Club reserves the right to cease provision without notice for any child that engages in any of these behaviours.

By booking to attend Breakfast or After School Club you are agreeing to the terms of this behaviour agreement
